Re: SARS-CoV-2 testing platform at ASU Biodesign Clinical Testing Laboratory

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter serves as documentation that the clinical test performed in the ASU Biodesign Clinical Testing Laboratory (ABCTL) for the diagnosis of SARS-CoV-2 infection is a real-time quantitative polymerase chain reaction (qPCR) analysis of a freshly collected saliva sample.

The ABCTL molecular test amplifies three different SARS-CoV-2-specific genes: the N gene, the ORF1ab gene, and the S gene. A negative test is one in which the control genetic material spiked into each test sample amplifies as expected, which documents that the test itself was technically successful, but none of the three target SARS-CoV-2 genes are detected.

The ABCTL is a CLIA certified laboratory (CLIA ID number: 03D2180875). Test results from the ABCTL are issued in the form of individual laboratory reports for each tested individual.
